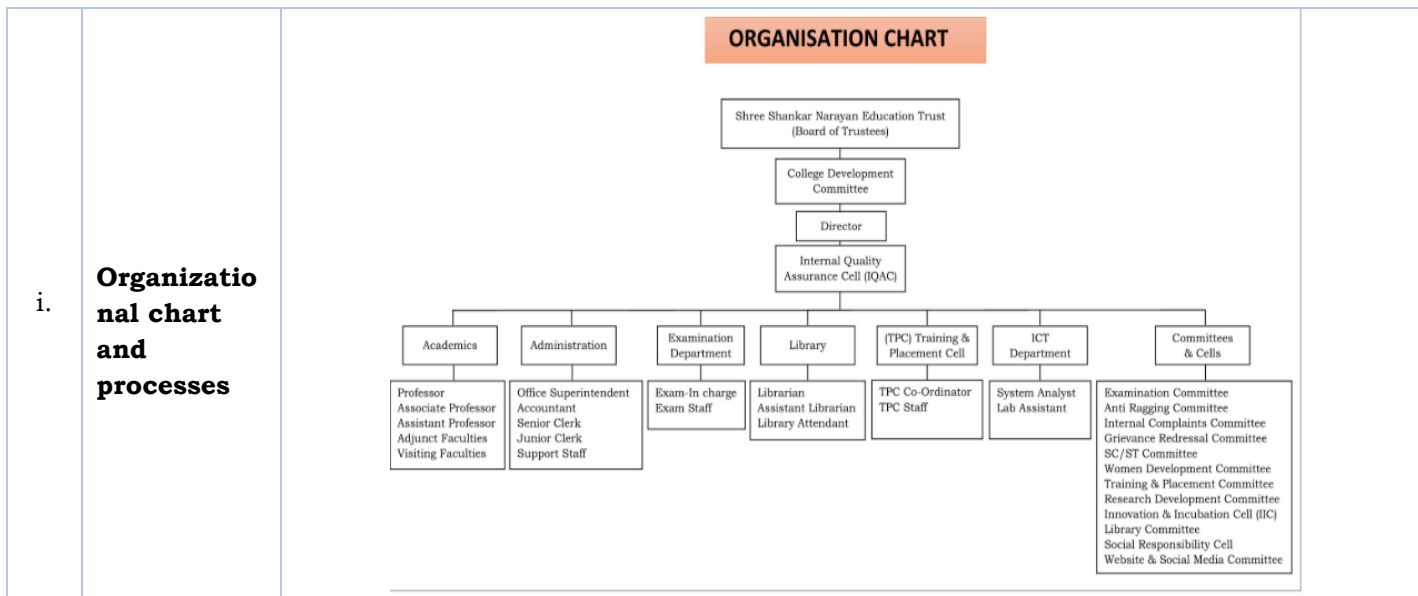

- In order to provide opportunities for redressal of certain grievances of Faculty, Staff & students already enrolled in institution as well as for those seeking admission to institution, AICTE has notified (Redressal of Grievance of Students) Regulations, 2019 vide F. No. 1-101/PGRC/ AICTE/ Regulation/2019 dated 07.11.2019 for establishment of grievance redressal mechanism.
- Grievance Redressal Committee / Cell (GRC) has been constituted for Faculty, Staff & Student (Student Grievance Redressal Committee - SGRC)
- Appointment of OMBUDSMAN by the University
- Suggestion boxes have been placed in the college so that students are able to give their suggestions to the college management. The suggestions are reviewed frequently by the Management and necessary action is taken.
